ZEP EMERGING APPROACHES

- A. Interventions may cover different levels: sitio, barangay, municipal, or provincial; point of contact is a family not an individual; point of contact will be via the community participative planning
- B. Initiator may be a ZEP or non-ZEP member; if non-ZEP member it is not logged into our database
- C. Initiator may become Local Convenor, invites other local players which eventually evolve into a ZEP local convergence;
- D. It becomes a convergence if more than one organization is doing the work and there is collaboration
- E. Local Convergence may include ZEP local members and non-members but are local players
- F. Local convenors may not be a ZEP member but there should be at least a member of ZEP in a local convergence

EMERGING MODELS

- A. The initiator is an organization capable of bringing in various facets of poverty intervention; it may still need to bring in others
- B. Start with own programs but connect with those in the locality who can fill in the gaps
- C. Locally initiated but with support from the national
- D. Two clusters talking together and engaging an initiator on the ground that is not a ZEP member; another way of multiplying the number of communities we serve
- E. Non-ZEP doing something close to ZEP; they may become members or partners; we are not rigid with the membership and there maybe others doing also the work and we can work with them

EMERGING ROLES

- A. The initiator is capable of bringing in all the facets of poverty intervention
- B. Start with own programs but connect with those in the locality for the gaps
- C. Locally initiated but with support from the national
- D. Two clusters talking together and engaging an initiator on the ground that is not a ZEP member
- E. Non-ZEP doing something close to ZEP; they may become members or partners

ROLES OF THE CLUSTERS

- 1. Identify areas without initiators and tap potential initiators
- 2. Monitor and analyze emerging thematic issues
- 3. Identify gaps in program/service delivery
- 4. Reach out to non-ZEP members that are already serving the extreme poor
- 5. Resolve issues on the cluster level

ROLES OF THE LEAD CONVENORS

- 1. Monitor the whole national targets and actively pursue the timelines
- 2. Oversight role –other issues not at the cluster but critical to reaching targets
- 3. Arbiter between clusters and local convergence and to look for solutions and anticipate possible problems in able to reach targets
- 4. Identify funding needs and gaps
